Upper-Division Biology Elective Units* - Complete **at least four (4) or eight (8) units** of upper-division coursework offered by the UC San Diego Division of Biological Sciences. Number of elective units needed will vary depending on the EBE Core courses and upper-division Biology lab selected.

* Upper-division Biology elective units may be completed with courses numbered 100-189 taken through UC San Diego's Division of Biological Sciences. Elective units may include one quarter of BISP 195, up to four Blxx 194s, and one quarter of either BISP 193 or BISP 196/197/199. Electives may also include SIO 123, 125, 126, 127, 128, 132, 133, 134, 147, 181, and 189. Only one BISP 196/197/199 can apply towards the major.
