Biohazardous liquids with CHEMICAL contamination	For chemically contaminated biohaz waste, contact the EH&S Environmental Management Facility, (858) 534-2753, for instructions.
Biohazardous liquids with RADIOACTIVE contamination	For radioactive waste, read the BLINK Link How To Store and Dispose of Radioactive Waste for instructions on disposal of mixed infectious-radioactive waste.

## **Autoclaving Biohazardous Waste**

Contact the Division of Biological Sciences' Safety Office if your lab needs to autoclave biohazardous material **prior to disposal**. The process is highly regulated and biohazardous material must be processed in specific autoclave units.
