Elective units may include one quarter of BISP 195, up to four B1xx 194s, and one quarter of either BISP 193 or BISP 196/197/199. Electives may also include SIO 121, 123, 124, 125, 126, 127, 128, 129, 131, 132, 133, 134, 138, 147, 181, and 189. Only one BISP 196/197/199 can apply towards the major.
